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POLITICAL ENVIRONMENT AND REGULATORY FRAMEWORK FOR ALLIANCES

November 2024

<u>Maximizing the impact of European University alliances</u> (LERU Advice Paper no. 35): The League of European Research Universities highlights in this contribution the achievements of the alliances for streamlining cross-border collaboration. The paper argues for the alignment of available funding programmes and of European, national and regional sources to ensure a long-term success of the initiatives. Also, political support in reducing legal and administrative barriers for collaboration is called for.

November 2024

<u>Developing common learning opportunities through interoperability</u> (EUA Briefing by Thomas Jorgensen, Clare Phelan, Liliya Kukuruza): The authors analyse the obstacles of seamless and secure data sharing across institutional and national boundaries.

December 2024

Align-Act-Accelerate: Research, Technology and Innovation to boost European competitiveness: This interim evaluation of Horizon Europe was presented by a Commission Expert Group chaired by Manuel Heitor. The report calls explicitly for '(s)trengthening European Universities' Alliances to promote learning and institutional cooperation and development across borders.' This recommendation is elaborated on in Chapter 8 on 'Foster an attractive and inclusive RD&I ecosystem in the EU': Joint recruitment and joint governance systems are called for in support of harnessing the potential of alliances to develop as laboratories for knowledge development, learning across barriers and establishing good practices.

December 2024

Report on the final outcomes of the Erasmus+ policy experimentation projects: European Degree (label) and institutionalised EU cooperation instruments: DG EAC summarises in this Commission staff working document the analysed of all pilot projects implemented by alliances during 2023. The report includes a detailed analysis on the added value a European degree could bring. It presents a unified and consensual list of 16 co-created European criteria and the rationale for each of them. Other key suggestions include the development of toolkits and guidelines to operationalise the co-created European criteria, the definition of a clear implementation roadmap and promoting the European degree to enhance its recognition and valorisation.

Additionally, the report provides insights on the testing of existing European level solutions for a legal status for alliances of higher education institutions, along with recommendations for the future, although a roadmap for next steps is missing for this part.
