

The pool of services to inter-campus students

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Executive summary/abstract:

Development of Roadmap for student inter-campus life (WP3) on the lamStudent project, requires the main results

R.3.1. The pool of services to inter-campus students consists of variety of services, academic offers, joint activities, joint organisations, etc. that are offers by international universities alliances for inter-campus students;

R.3.2. 'Roadmap for student inter-campus life' model will be the basis to structure the services, academic offers, curriculum development, soft skills, etc. any alliance offer or could offer to their students;

R.3.3. Pilot model of EU-CONEXUS Roadmap for inter-campus life.

In the mapping process, existing services for inter-campus students were reviewed. This included an examination of EU-CONEXUS academic offerings, research offers, Summer schools, Alliance promotions, Student associations, Campus life, Activities for strengthening alliance identity and IT services were identified, with a focus on potential inter-campus activities. This mapping exercise also involved conducting interviews with other alliances to further understand what could be offered as inter-campus activities.

Description:

Following the compilation of Academic Offers, Research Opportunities, Alliance Promotion Activities, Student Associations, Campus Life, Alliance Strengthening Activities, and IT Services included in the EU-CONEXUS alliance, we further expanded our list by integrating information from other university alliances.

Each partner involved in the lamStudent project participated in an interview with a representative from their respective alliance, who possessed an in-depth understanding of the alliance's structure and the activities it offers. Prior to the interview, each participant completed a table with the required data pertaining to their respective alliance. The purpose of the interview was for each institutional coordinator to establish contact with a representative from another alliance—preferably one that includes a partner from the same country—enabling a discussion on the student services offered in their native language.
